March Madness takes on a whole different meaning here in Utah. The end of the Legislative Session is a few days away, candidate filing begins on March 12th, and we are hosting Precinct Caucuses on March 23rd. There are 850 precincts in Salt Lake County, so we have been busy preparing.

For those of you who are unfamiliar with a Precinct Caucus, it is grassroots activism at its finest. We will be electing Precinct Officers for all 850 Precincts. The Precinct Officers are responsible for helping organize their neighborhood by talking to their neighbors about our candidates. We have formalized this process this year with specific training and guidance and have an entire infrastructure ready to help you out. Precinct Chairs and Vice-Chairs also serve on our Central Committee, which decides the future of our County Party.

We will also be electing 1,234 delegates to the County and State Conventions. Here in Salt Lake County, we have some exciting contests for County Council At Large, District Attorney, and County Council District 1. By attending your Precinct Caucus and being elected a delegate, you will play a pivotal role in choosing our nominees.
