SALT LAKE CITY (December 1, 2009) – As Senator Scott McCoy resigns his seat, the Salt Lake County Democratic Party will meet to select his replacement. The delegates in the 2nd Senate District will meet in the upcoming weeks to elect a replacement. According to the Salt Lake County Democratic Party constitution, if nobody receives 60% of the votes of the delegates on the first ballot, the top two candidates will be on a second ballot with the candidate receiving the majority of votes to be selected. The delegates were elected to their position at the 2007 precinct caucuses.

Upon learning of Sen. McCoy's resignation, Salt Lake County Democratic Party Chair Weston Clark stated "Sen. McCoy has been a tireless advocate for his constituents and we are thankful for his work over the past 4 years in the Legislature. Sen.
